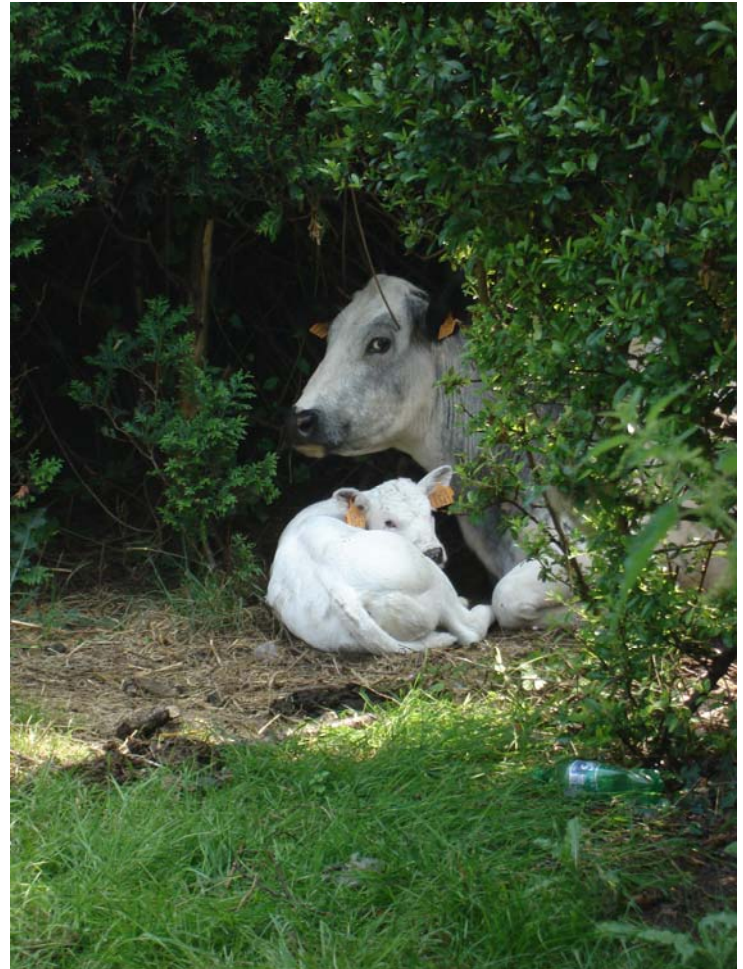
Lack of basic knowledge

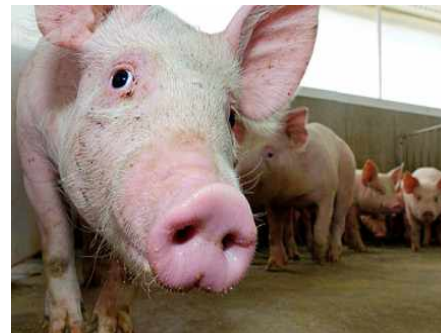

Dog and Cat

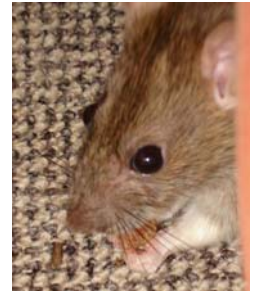
